

GUARANTEE POLICY

Sale Trees (Discount of 25% or more) have NO guarantee!

FIRST SUMMER PURCHASED

All of our trees & shrubs are 100% GUARANTEED to grow the first season.

If the tree or shrub dies, you must return the dead tree or shrub along with sales receipt **BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1ST** to receive a 100% credit that must be used towards the purchase of another tree or shrub. No cash will be given.

After September 1st, receive a 50% credit of the original purchase price.

If the tree or shrub dies after September 1st, you must return the dead tree or shrub along with the sales receipt to receive a 50% credit of the original purchase price that can be used towards the purchase of another tree or shrub. Return must be within 1 year from date of purchase. Discount will be subtracted from original price & refund will be adjusted accordingly. No cash will be given. Please see a Beier's associate for a copy of the complete guarantee qualifications.

PERENNIAL POLICY

There are some varieties of perennials that are zoned hardy to this area and will come back year after year. Look for the varieties that are for zone 2 or 3B for the best chance of surviving our northern winters. When planting perennials that are for zones 4 or 5 you should consider them as annuals. We have perennial care sheets available please feel free pick one up. **Due to our unpredictable winters we cannot guarantee perennials.**

HYBRID TEA ROSE POLICY

Hybrid tea Roses are typically grown as an annual in our northern climate. However there are several methods of trying to protect them. Please take a copy of our rose care sheet for some suggestions. (We do not recommend rose cones this far north, as they typically do not provide enough protection, for the rose plant to survive.) Due to our unpredictable winters we can not guarantee the Hybrid Tea Roses. However, we recommend trying the shrub type rose plants, for this area as they are much more hardy and they typically will survive the winter.



SALES POLICY ANNUAL PLANT POLICY
